RE: Morgan Fall Landfill (Fulton County) Minor Modification

Due to recent approval of four 300 ft. radio towers at the Morgan Fall Landfill by the City of Sandy Springs , a minor modification application may be before your division soon. We would like to be notified of any public comment period on that application. Sandy Springs Council of Neighborhoods is concerned that digging in the closed, unlined land fill when installing the radio towers in the rubbish could be a hazard for the nearby apartments.

The landfill suffered a major petroleum pipeline leak in March of 1998 due to the pipe collapsing on itself when laid in the rubbish. Even if the radio towers are on solid bedrock, there is a concern that the deep drilling will allow the leachate from the unlined land fill to contaminate surrounding areas.

We appreciate your close scrutiny of any proposed work in the area with nearby baseball fields, apartments and the Chattahoochee River at risk. We feel that any further contamination in this area will be detrimental to our community and neighborhoods.
