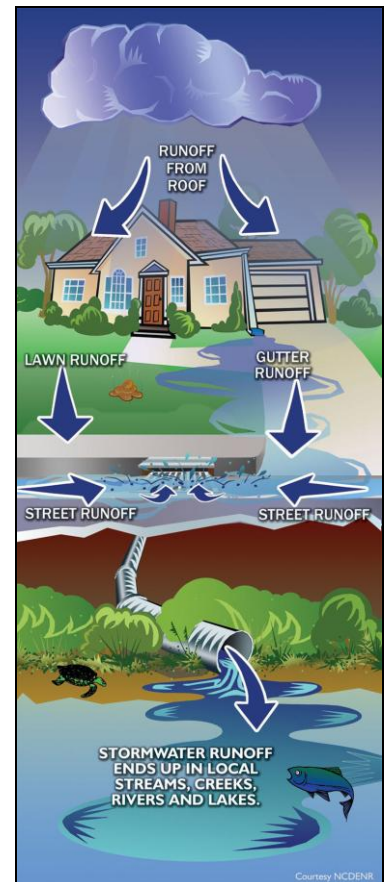
A brief business meeting will precede the presentation and will cover the work of SSCN in 2009 and focus for 2010. There will also be an election of new Directors.
